Dear Friends of J. W. J. N.,

It is with great honor to introduce our inaugural annual report for 2013. It was a year of milestones for the I.W.I.N. Foundation resulting from eleven years of dedication and perseverance to build support for women with breast cancer throughout the state. We served three women during our first year and are now serving approximately 450 women annually. Entering the year, there was only one county in Indiana that we had not yet served - Switzerland County. Due to our enhanced collaborations with our referral partners (social workers, physicians and nurse navigators) we are proud to announce that our services have been utilized in all 92 counties in the state of Indiana and that we increased our services to an additional 100 women this year.

Our most exciting accomplishment in 2013 is reaching our MILLION DOLLAR milestone. We have now delivered over 1 million dollars in relief services to women in treatment for breast cancer. This relief came in the form of transportation assistance, grocery cards and prepared meals, house cleaning, lawn maintenance, snow removal, childcare, yoga and massage therapy. Whatever was needed by these courageous women fighting breast cancer to make their lives just a little easier, we provided. These significant accomplishments could not be possible without the generous support of our corporate and community partners, donors, volunteers, board members and dedicated staff. We thank you for believing in our mission and supporting our goal to serve women in all 92 Indiana counties. Your generosity has allowed I.W.I.N. to continue to relieve the emotional, physical and financial burdens experienced by our recipients. It has also put us on the path of being able to serve all women in Indiana reaching out to I.W.I.N.

asking for support in their time of need.

The staff and board of I.W.I.N. remain committed to serving breast cancer patients in treatment and have recently established new strategic priorities to further elevate support of its mission. As awareness of our program has grown throughout the state, so has the number of requests for I.W.I.N.'s support. 



Fiscal Year 2013 Fundraising Highlights

In order to provide Indiana women with the customized personal support they need to endure breast cancer treatment, the I.W.I.N. Foundation raises funds through its annual signature event, The Pink Pajama Party. I.W.I.N. hosted its Ninth Annual Pink Pajama Party on February 22nd and 23rd, 2013 at the Indianapolis Marriott North Keystone at the Crossing raising over \$60,000. The evening featured a night of pampering for over 325 breast cancer survivors, their friends and family while dressed in pink pajamas. The event included a cocktail reception, silent auction, raffle, dinner, and complimentary salon and spa services with entertainment by local band favorite, Living Proof. The program was emceed by Emmy award-winning Anne- Marie Tiernon, co-anchor of WTHR. Guests stayed overnight and enjoyed a breakfast program the next morning.



Nearly \$65,000 was raised by community organizations, schools, businesses, retailers, salons, church groups and fitness centers. These organizations held a variety of fundraising events such as golf events, fashion shows, craft sales, sporting events, dress down days, home pajama parties, and pool parties with proceeds benefiting the I.W.I.N. Foundation.
